Titilaka, Puno, Peru

This surprisingly modern 18-room luxury retreat stands on a private peninsula that juts into Lake Titicaca, a body of water split between Peru and Bolivia. Arrive early and the staff will pick you up by car and proceed to the hotel.

Then it's all about amenities, like spa bathrooms with oversized tubs, floor-to-ceiling views of the lake, and fabulous food. The concierge will arrange activities, such as a quarter-day hike to an ancient Incan arch from where you can see surrounding local communities, or a drive and boat ride to the floating islands of Uros. *Rooms start at \$500 (per person per night, all-inclusive); Centro Poblado Titilaka; 51-1/700-5106; titilaka.pe.*
